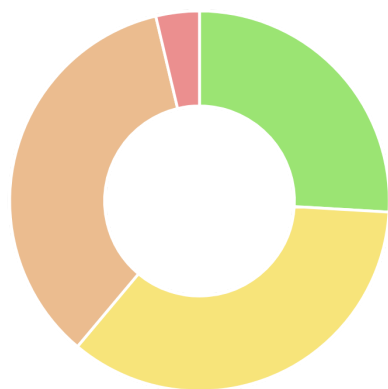


Orchard Public Input Survey

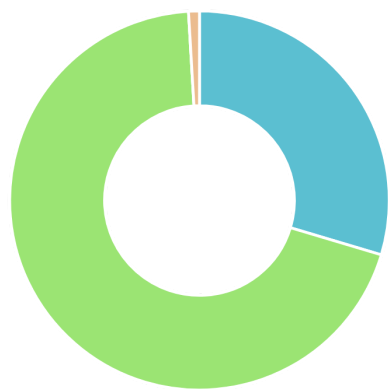

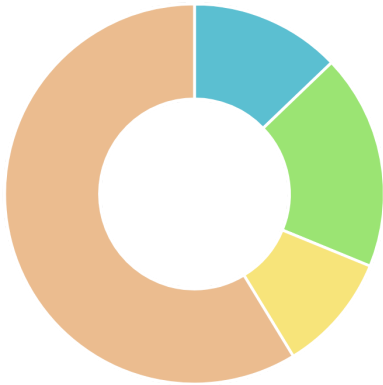
2 Gender: How do you identify?



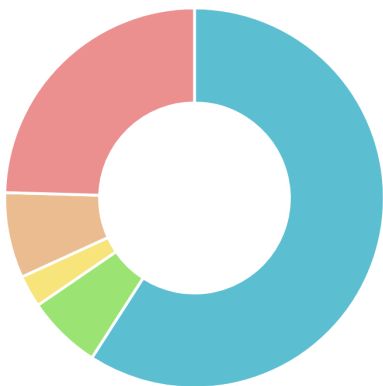

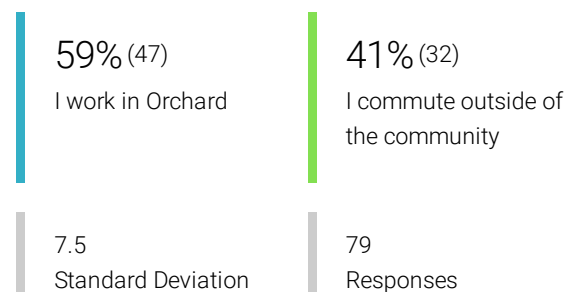
3 How long have you lived in Orchard?



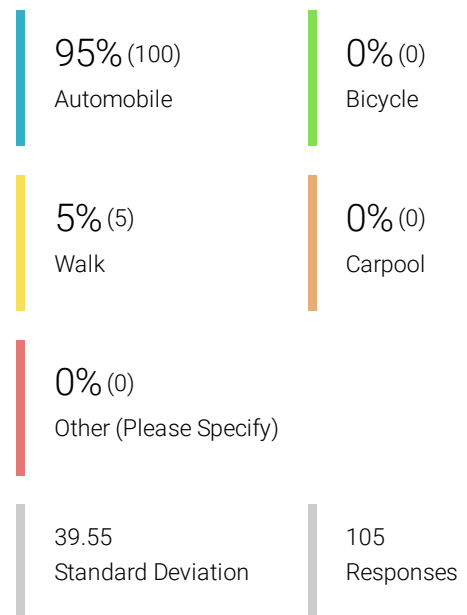
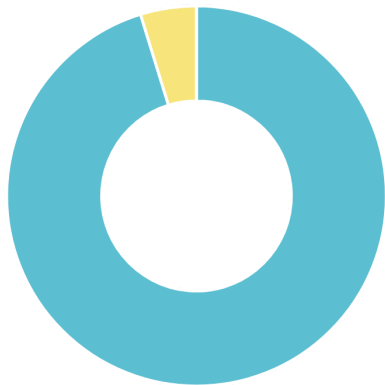
4 What is your current employment status?



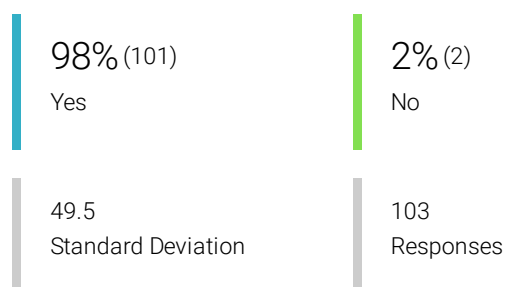
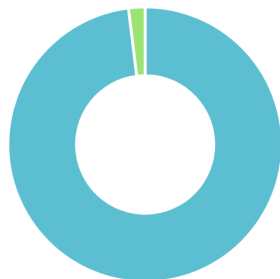
5 If you are employed, do you work in Orchard or commute outside of the community?



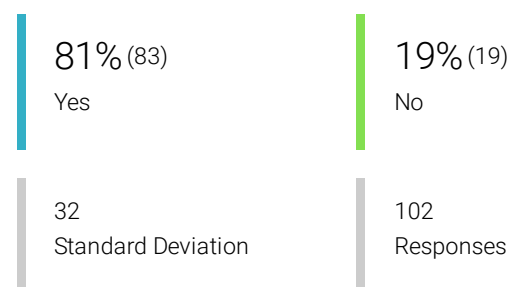
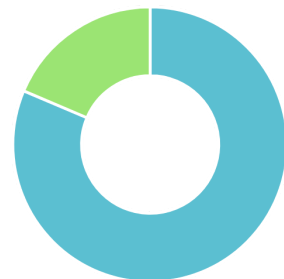
7 What is your primary mode of transportation?



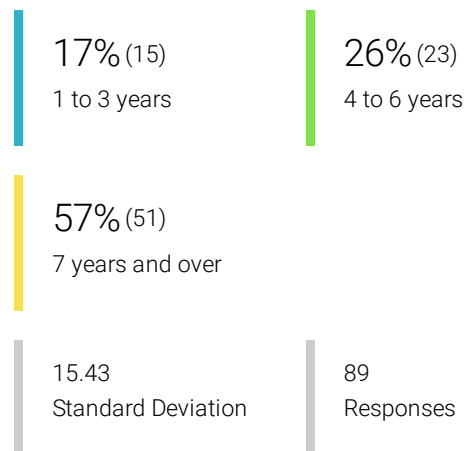
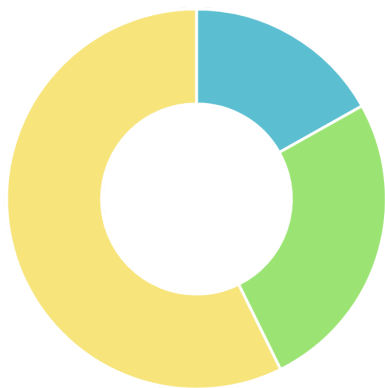
8 Are you concerned with the quality of streets in your neighborhood?



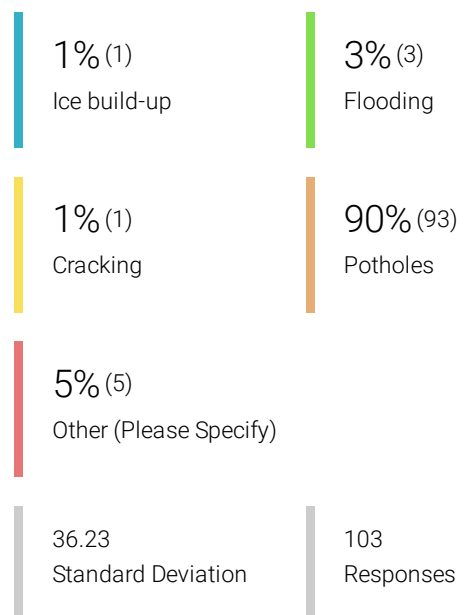
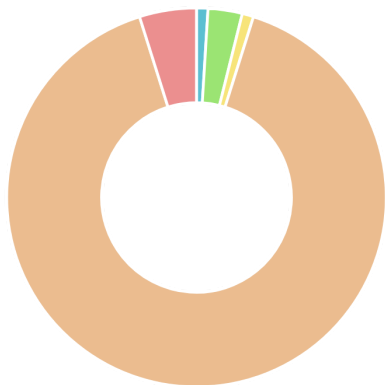
9 Do you feel the quality of streets negatively impacts your day-to-day life?

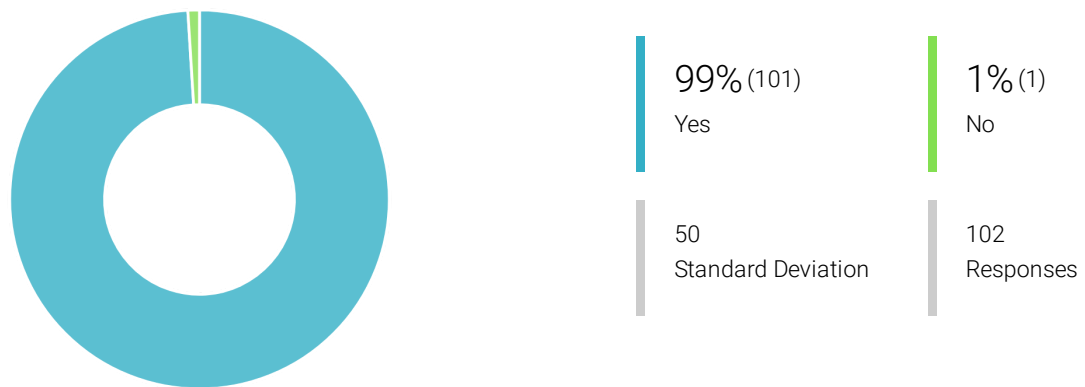
